Call for Papers

Geohazards, Natural Disasters, and Risk Assessment addresses the identification, monitoring, analysis, and management of geological and natural hazards and their impacts on people, infrastructure, ecosystems, and communities. The field also considers disaster preparedness, mitigation, resilience, emergency response, and climate change adaptation to support effective risk reduction and sustainable development.
