Complications of Pregnancy is an academic and clinical field that studies medical conditions and adverse events affecting the mother, fetus or both during pregnancy, childbirth and the postpartum period. It examines the causes, risk factors, diagnosis, prevention and management of complications such as preeclampsia, gestational diabetes, preterm birth, placental disorders and maternal infections. The field aims to improve maternal and neonatal health outcomes through advances in obstetric care, clinical practice and public health.

In this special issue, we intend to invite front-line researchers and authors to submit original research and review articles on **Complications of Pregnancy**. Potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Maternal critical care and obstetric emergencies
